

**WEST WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE
REGULAR MEETING ON OCTOBER 18, 2005**

The West Wendover City Council met for a regular meeting on October 18, 2005. The meeting was held at the West Wendover Library, Pilot Peak Room. Mayor Thaut presided.

The following proceedings were had.

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Mayor Thaut called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All those present and excused are noted above.

2. PLDEGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Thaut led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC:

None offered or received.

4. *APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

Council Member Reilly made the motion to forward the minutes of the regular meeting on September 20, 2005 to the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Carter and passed unanimously.

5. NEW BUSINESS

***a. Discussion and Decision for Approval to Send Staff to the 2005 Nevada Governors Conference on Tourism in Las Vegas Nevada on December 12-14, 2005 and Other Matters Appropriately Related Thereto**

Chris Melville explained that this would be to send 3 staff members as well as any Council Members or the Mayor who would like to attend. The staff members would be Kerrie Supanich, Linda Brown and Chris Melville. Council Member Reilly made the motion to authorize up to 5 people to attend the 2005 Nevada Governors Conference on Tourism in Las Vegas Nevada on December 12-14, 2005. The motion was seconded by Council Member Troyan and passed unanimously.

***b. Discussion and Decision Regarding Sponsoring Anna Smith Elementary PTO Trick or Treat Street and Other Matters Appropriately Related Thereto**

Anna Bartlome explained that this was the annual event and the City usually donates \$75.00. Council Member Reilly made the motion to sponsor 1 door at \$75.00 for the Anna Smith Elementary PTO Trick or Treat Street. The motion was seconded by Council Member Carter and passed unanimously.

6. COMMUNICATIONS

Council Member Carter stated that it was a fantastic week at the Nevada League of Cities, there were great meetings and learned a lot.

Council Member Troyan stated that at meetings she attended they stressed the importance of hiring and keeping good records. Another meeting discussed brining back government to a local level not federal. Council Member Troyan asked about the cars coming from the apartments to Florence Way. It was stated that it was because of paving going on at Butte Street. Discussion was had regarding the paving on Wendover Boulevard where the sewer line for Montego Bay was done.

Council Member Reilly explained that she also enjoyed the conference. General discussion was had regarding the meeting concerning the changes to the open meeting law, and the meeting concerning franchise fees and the potential loss of income. Council Member Reilly stated that she is working on ideas for the 21st Century Grant to get a mentoring program going at the school.

Chris Melville stated that the HR information covered was very useful, the POWER workshop was good, the tour of the Thunderbirds base, and the North beating the South at softball game.

Anna Bartlome stated that the open meeting class was good and the conference was good overall.

Ron Supp explained it was really good especially for a new department head, enjoyed it a lot.

Mayor Thaut stated that overall the facility was good and Las Vegas did a fairly good job holding the conference. Mayor Thaut stated that only two Mayors were missing from the Mayors meeting, and a commitment was made to meet every 3 months. Mayor Thaut stated that she and Chris Melville attended a reception for the new State Director of the BLM. Mayor Thaut also wanted to thank Jeff Knudtson for acting as City Manager while Chris was on vacation and at the conference.

Mayor Thaut asked when Pueblo Boulevard would be open. It was explained that it would be at least another couple of weeks before that section would be open. There had been some problems with the trucks matching up with the curb machine.

Bryce Kimber stated that Butte Street would be open tomorrow.

Council Member Troyan made the motion to approve the claims for October 18, 2005. The motion was seconded by Council Member Carter and passed unanimously.
