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### **WEST WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF MARCH 2, 2010**

The West Wendover City Council met for a regular meeting on March 2, 2010. The meeting was held at the West Wendover City Hall, Council Chambers #137. Mayor Andersen presided.

The following proceedings were had.

**1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL**

Mayor Andersen called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All those present and excused are noted above.

**2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mayor Andersen led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**3. COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC:**

None offered or received.

**4. \*APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:**

Council Member Gorum made the motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of February 16, 2010. The motion was seconded by Council Member Carter and passed unanimously.

**5. CONSENT CALENDAR**

**\*a. Discussion and Decision to Adopt Resolution #2010-04; A Resolution Approving and Adopting the City of West Wendover Water Conservation Plan of January 25, 2010**

Bryce Kimber explained that per NRS 540.131 (4a) the water conservation plan must be updated every five years and he would recommend adopting the plan. General discussion was had regarding the water conservation plan being public information and that flyers will be sent out concerning the plan. Council Member Carter made the motion to adopt Resolution #2010-04, a resolution approving and adopting the City of West Wendover Water Conservation Plan of January 25, 2010. The motion was seconded by Council Member Briggs and passed unanimously.

**6. NEW BUSINESS**

**\*a. Discussion and Decision Regarding Possible Donation to the Wendover Area Diabetes Coalition for the Wendover Diabetes Walk and Other Matters Appropriately Related Thereto**

Jamey Christie, representing the Diabetes Coalition, explained that this is the annual walk and would be held May 15, 2010. Jamey further explained that the doctors from Wendover Community Health Centers would be doing the presentations at the schools. Jamey further

stated that the Diabetes Coalition meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of every month and letters have been sent out to businesses for donations. Council Member Blake made the motion to donate \$2,000.00 to the Wendover Area Diabetes Coalition for the Wendover Diabetes Walk. The motion was seconded by Council Member Gorum and passed unanimously.

**7. DEPARTMENT UPDATES**

**Fire Chief** – Jeff Knudtson had nothing to add to memo, which stated that he had attended a meeting with the State DEM and DOE for the upcoming grant funding and should receive enough funding to replace all of the turn out gear and most of the air packs. Open applications for part time firefighters are still taking place with a few inquiries.

**Public Works Director** – Bryce Kimber had nothing to add to memo, which stated that the department has been cleaning up weeds in various parts of the City. The department helped with the move of the Police Department. The street sweeper had gone around in February and will go around again in the spring. The reuse crew is getting ready for the pumping season to the golf course by pulling two of the pumps to the #3 clarifier and unplugging them. Aqua Engineering is preparing to start the preliminary engineering for Phase 2 of the Waste Water Treatment Plant. The contractor cleaning up the Rippetoe property has brought approximately 318 tons of garbage to the landfill. The generator for Shafter Well #6 had been delivered but had the wrong fuel tank and a new one had to be ordered and would take an additional three to four weeks.
