

**WEST WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE JOINT
MEETING WITH THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE WEST
WENDOVER RECREATION DISTRICT ON MARCH 21, 2006**

The West Wendover City Council met for a joint meeting with the Board of Trustees of the West Wendover Recreation District on March 21, 2006. The meeting was held at the West Wendover Library, Pilot Peak Room. Mayor Thaut presided.

The following proceedings were had.

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Mayor Thaut called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. All those present and excused are noted above.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Thaut led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

4. ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

A. General Discussion

B. Toana Vista Golf Course

-Update on golf course operations and maintenance

Heidi Lewis explained that the golf course is open and that the first part of March had not been very good. The course is coming along well with the projects that have been done, which include some work on the bunkers. The State golf tournament will be held in West Wendover in May. Kurt Holm stated that there are still some of the same problems that they have every year, which include some problems with the greens, lining and adding sand to some of the bunkers, and the putting green should be open by the middle of June. Kurt stated that the sprinklers should be on at the end of the week and the new mowers will be arriving soon. They will give more detail to the aprons.

Reid Goodliffe stated that the course is open and a full year of events is scheduled. Reid further stated that the staffing is good.

-Update on sulphur burner

Kurt Holm stated that the sulphur burner would be fired up when the sprinklers are started.

C. Parks and Recreation

-Update on facilities and activities

Shawn Gregory explained that they are currently in the middle of the second session of Jr. Jazz. The first session ended February 25 and included grades 1st through 4th. The second session started February 28th and will go until April 13th and includes grades 5th through 8th. Youth league registration began on March 21st, which includes t-ball, softball and baseball. The REC Center will open early the week of March 27th through the 31st. The annual Easter Egg hunt will be on April 15th at the baseball fields. The swimming pool opening day is Memorial Day Weekend for weekends and will open full time on June 10th. Adult softball will begin the first part of June. Some rodeo, equestrian and some softball tournaments for the season are still being booked.

General discussion was had regarding loitering, fights, garbage, transients and drinking that have been taking place at the different recreation facilities. Discussion was had regarding adopting an ordinance which would include some guidelines of what would be allowed. General discussion was had regarding the timing of a new field.
