

WEST WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING ON MAY 11, 2006

The West Wendover City Council met for a special meeting on May 11, 2006. The meeting was held at the West Wendover Library, Pilot Peak Room. Mayor Thaut presided.

The following proceedings were had.

1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Mayor Thaut called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. All those present and excused are noted above.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mayor Thaut led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC:

None offered or received.

4. ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

***a. Discussion and Decision Regarding Whether to Proceed with a Draft Ordinance for Appropriately Related Thereto**

General discussion was had regarding what minimum number of requirements would be included in an Ordinance, which included 150 rooms available for sleeping accommodations, and one bar with permanent seating for 15 patrons that serves alcoholic beverages sold by the drink for consumption on the premises. The Ordinance also included one restaurant which must have permanent seating capacity for more than 100 patrons and open to the public 24 hours a day 7 days a week. Mayor Thaut reread the potential draft Ordinance with the numbers as discussed included into the reading. Council Member Reilly made the motion to proceed with drafting an Ordinance for resort hotel non-restricted gaming establishments with the minimum rooms at 150, one bar with permanent seating for 15, one restaurant which must have seating for 100 patrons that is open to the public 24 hours a day 7 days a week, and a gaming area dedicated to a non-restricted operation within the building or group of buildings. The motion was seconded by Council Member Gorum and passed unanimously.

Chris Melville explained that a draft ordinance would be prepared and ready for the first meeting in June.

5. *NEXT MEETING DATE AND ADJOURNMENT

The next meeting date is a regular meeting on May 16, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. at the West Wendover Library, Pilot Peak Room. Council Member J. Carter made the motion to adjourn at 6:35 p.m. The motion was seconded by Council Member Reilly and passed unanimously.
