

WEST WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING ON JULY 5, 2005

The West Wendover City Council met for a regular meeting on July 5, 2005. The meeting was held at the West Wendover Library, Pilot Peak Room. Mayor Thaut presided.

The following proceedings were had.

1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL**
Mayor Thaut called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All those present and excused are noted above.
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**
Mayor Thaut led those present in the Pledge of allegiance.
3. **COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC:**
Jessica Lewis explained that she would be competing in the Miss Elko County pageant and needed to have a sponsorship in order to compete. The potential sponsorship of the pageant and/or the placement of ads for the pageant would be placed on the next agenda.
4. ***APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:**
Council Member Troyan made the motion to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on June 7, 2005 and the regular meeting of June 21, 2005. The motion was seconded by Council Member Gunter and passed unanimously.
5. **NEW BUSINESS**
***a. Discussion and Decision for Approval to Send Officers Boatman and Morris to First Aid/CPR Instructor training in Winnemucca Nevada on July 15-17, 2005 and Other Matters Appropriately Related Thereto**
Ron Supp explained that the long-range plan and goal is to have Officers trained in the department that can be instructors and train the other Officers and keep certifications current. Council Member Miera made the motion to approve sending Officers Boatman and Morris to First Aid/CPR Instructor training in Winnemucca Nevada on July 15-17, 2005. The motion was seconded by Council Member Troyan and passed unanimously.
6. **DEPARTMENT UPDATES**
Teen Council – Not present.
Fire Chief – Nothing to add to memo, which included the following the ADO class (Pumper Apparatus Driver Operator), is still ongoing and testing should be in August. Gary Corona explained that he had attended a meeting concerning LEPC and was continuing the

preparations for the 4th of July. Jeremy Loncar stated that all the inspections and revisions at the Montego Bay have been going very well and he is currently reviewing the Fire Alarm System ensuring that it meets our code as well as has Jack Spielmans approval. Staci Johnson explained that the car seat checkpoint on June 28th ran smoothly. Staci also has given the State curriculum for the required violator training to Judge Grant.

Police Chief – Nothing to add to memo, which states that the Department responded to the following calls: 474 calls for service, 17 adult arrests and 3 juvenile arrests.

City Clerk/Records Officer – Nothing.

Chief Financial Officer – Leon Flinders stated that he is just preparing for the annual audit.

Public Works Director – Not present. Mayor Thaut stated that the sulphur burner is being moved and the project at Scobie Park is about 90% complete.

City Manager – Chris Melville explained that the trees for Pueblo Boulevard are currently at the Public Works, and the trees for the Ventura trailer park would be planted soon. The funding agreement for Leppy Hills would be signed tomorrow, once that is done the environmental study will start. Chris further stated that the environmental for the Wendover Boulevard CDBG project had begun. The Florence Way project should be underway sometime next week. The bids for Pueblo Boulevard project would be opened at the end of the month with the award at the first meeting in August.

7. **COMMUNICATIONS**

Council Member Carter stated that the 4th of July was a great event.

Council Member Miera asked if a letter could be sent to Mr. Tow concerning his fence. Chris Melville explained that a letter had been sent giving him 90 days to fix his fence and that would be up at the end of July. Also a letter had been sent to Mr. Tow from Tom Coyle explaining that the time for completing the process was almost over.

Council Member Troyan asked about the cement and dirt down by Mr. Tow's yard if it was going to be removed. It was explained that it is being removed. Council Member Troyan stated that she would not be present for the meetings on July 19th and August 2nd. Council Member Troyan stated that everyone loved the fireworks.

8. ***APPROVAL OF THE CLAIMS:**

Council Member Troyan made the motion to approve the claims for July 5, 2005. The motion was seconded by Council Member Carter and passed unanimously.
