### **WEST WENDOVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF AUGUST 26, 2010**

The West Wendover City Council met for a special meeting on August 26, 2010. The meeting was held at the West Wendover City Hall, Council Chambers #137. Mayor Andersen presided.

The following proceedings were had.

1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL**  
Mayor Andersen called the meeting to order at 4:36 p.m. All those present and excused are noted above.
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**  
Mayor Andersen led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. **COMMENTS FROM THE GENERAL PUBLIC:**

4. **NEW BUSINESS**  
**\*a. Discussion and Decision to Authorize the Mayor to Execute the Lease Agreement between the City of West Wendover Nevada and Dun Transportation and Stringing Inc. for 5 Acres More or Less in the City's Industrial Park and Other Matters Appropriately Related Thereto**  
Chris Melville explained that this lease agreement is based on the previous agreement with US Pipeline. Chris explained some of the changes to the agreement, which included the property description and location, the lease amount, requiring of first and last months lease payment, and adding of section 11 which deals with environmental issues. The term of the agreement is a minimum of seven months. Council Member Blake made the motion to authorize the Mayor to execute the lease agreement between the City of West Wendover Nevada and Dun Transportation and Stringing Inc. for 5 acres more or less in the City's Industrial Park. The motion was seconded by Council Member Carter and passed unanimously.
