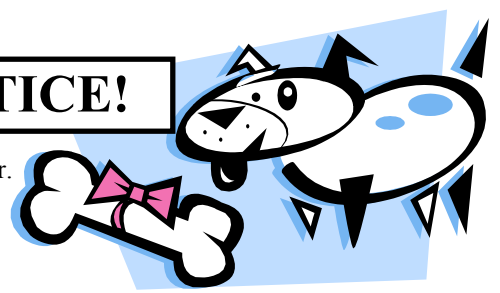


IMPORTANT PUBLIC NOTICE!



Beginning January 1, 2007, there will be new pet licensing fees for pets in West Wendover. These new fees are part of the City's desire to foster pet care and encourage pet licensing. This is important not only for the protection of pets, but the protection of pet owners and the general public.

Unlicensed pets are generally pets that are neglected, uncared for and unvaccinated. Unvaccinated pets pose a great danger to the owner, to other pets in the community and overall to the general welfare of the public through viruses and diseases which they can carry and transmit. In addition, unlicensed pets, which are lost and picked up by concerned residents or the City's Animal Control, are extremely difficult to reunite with their owners. The result is that someone's loving pet can end up being destroyed if it cannot be reunited with an existing owner or adopted by a potential new owner.

The City's Animal Control Department is not only meant to control nuisance pet issues in the community but these professionals should be turned to for help in many situations that you as a pet owner may find yourself dealing with. Animal Control is there to help and to assist you with information and providing access to other important resources, which can be used for the proper care of your pets.

Owning a pet is not a game but an important personal responsibility. A pet should never be considered a fashion accessory. It is caring for another life. Please take the time to license your pet and ensure its proper care so that you and your pet can be an integral part of our community.
